

- Welcome to our Strategic Plan, covering the period 2023-2025
- This document explains our strategic priorities and how they came about.



- We started our planning process in 2022 by reviewing our environment and establishing our Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and threats (SWOT).
- From this, we identified some overarching themes which we put out for consultation to all our stakeholders, including staff, professionals and the public.
- We ran a series of internal workshops throughout the organisation, to refine the feedback and from this, the management team proposed four strategic priorities.
